
Phone Surveys

- •1,000 respondents
- •44% Current Trail Users
- 66% are unaware of the Circuit
- •77% of those aware of trails have HH income of \$50K+
- •78% of users think about quality of water and it's impact on their overall quality of life




Trail Usage by Age Groups






Typical Trail-side Respondent




- Age 46 to 65

- 50 Surveys
- Crafted outreach methods
